



Photography Standards: To ensure the quality of the Oklahoma Film + Music Office locations database, we kindly ask that you review the photography guidelines outlined below prior to submitting your location.

- **Permissions and Credits:** If the photos were taken by someone else, please ensure you have permission and provide appropriate credit, especially for professional photography.
- **Image Orientation and Quantity:** Horizontal or panoramic images are preferred over vertical ones to better align with widescreen film formats. Include multiple photos from different angles; locations with only one photo cannot be used.
- **Interior and Exterior Shots:** Provide both exterior and interior photos. If interior photos are not available, please note this in the usage restrictions.
- **Professional Photography and Watermarks:** If possible, submit images without watermarks or decals from professional photographers.
- **Content Focus:** Focus on the location itself, avoiding photos with people, festivals, pets, etc. For example, empty restaurant or bar photos are preferred over those with customers.
- **Weather Conditions:** Avoid photos taken in inclement weather unless photographing nature. Clear weather photos provide a "blank canvas" for filmmakers.
- **Lighting:** Use natural lighting whenever possible. Be mindful of how the time of day affects the appearance of the location.
- **Photo Quality:** Ensure the photos are high-resolution (1280 x 720 or greater), clear, and not blurry.
- **Filters and Lenses:** Please avoid using untraditional filters, lenses, or framing from social media apps like Instagram or Snapchat.
