**FILM INSTRUCTOR - The Solebury School – FILM ANALYSIS: SCENE BY SEEN.** Doug Claybourne and L.D. Napier conceived and designed a Course with Napier as a writer/director and Claybourne as a producer team teaching a “learn by doing” film course. SCENE BY SEEN allows students to stage and shoot scenes from the films Claybourne has produced or assistant directed. The 10 students enrolled each trimester rotate crew positions allowing them to “learn by doing to jobs of each crew person.” Each student directs, assistant directs, operates camera, does lighting, sound etc. while Claybourne gives inside information on how the scenes were shot on set. The class critiques the final student work in class. Scenes are then edited to view by the entire school at the end of the Trimester. Each new trimester, another film is chosen to examine by students. We have workshoped scenes from RUMBLE FISH, FAST and THE FURIOUS, THE MASK OF ZORRO & APOCALYPSE NOW have been filmed to date.
